-  6:00 PM — Depart for Home

Caravan FAQs

What time is the Caravan leaving Wal-mart?

We will be leaving at 10:00 AM. Please try and arrive by 9:00 AM so that we can leave promptly at 10:00 AM.

Can we leave our cars in the parking lot?

We have prearranged with Commerce City Hall to have vehicles parked at Wal-mart.

How much luggage can we bring?

We are requesting you only bring one bag for under the bus and one carry on.

What time will we be leaving DC and what time do we expect to arrive home?

The March begins at 11:30 AM and the Rally begins at 1:00 PM. The Rally is tentatively scheduled to be over at 4PM. More speakers are confirming and so it may run later than that. We are estimating that we will be meeting up at the bus at 5:30 and departing at 6:00PM. It is about a 10 hour drive home. We will be driving through the night and arrive back at Wal-mart in the early morning hours of Sunday, the 13th.

What about food during the ride to Washington, DC?

Please bring a brown-bag type of lunch. We are asking everyone to bring a little extra of their favorite snacks to share. We will be stopping for dinner at a fast-food restaurant for a quick order and back on the bus to complete the trip.

What about food on the way home?

We would suggest buying snacks from a local vendor at the rally if you are immediately hungry. We will be stopping after about an hour on the road to get something. We can decide as a group when we get on the bus.

Is there a bathroom on the bus?

Absolutely! We will also be making brief stops at rest areas along the way.

Can we bring pillows and blankets on the bus?

Yes! We encourage you to bring anything that will make you comfortable for a long drive.

Where are we staying?

We will be staying at the Best Western, 45440 Holiday Drive, Sterling, Va. It is about 30 minutes outside of Washington, DC. We will meet at 7:00AM for breakfast at the hotel. (free hot continental breakfast) and then head to Rally. Please check out of hotel!.

Its pretty early. Will there be coffee?

We are trying to coordinate having enough coffee to get everyone moving.

Should we bring anything to the March and Rally?

We would suggest signs, flags, water, personal coolers and a poncho for rain. You may also bring chairs. Please remember you will need to carry what you wish to bring.

How will we be getting to the March and to the Rally?

We will be taking the bus into the city. The bus will drop us off at Union Station and we will take the Metro to the rally point to begin the March. Some members will be going to the Capitol early in the morning to try and reserve space for us for the rally.

Is there a meet-up point for those not traveling on the bus?

We will be meeting at Freedom Plaza on the corner of Pennsylvania and 14th Street @ 9:00. The March begins at 11:30. Everyone will be wearing a White Georgia By Land T-Shirt and organized by state. Look for the Georgia Flag, American Flag and our T-shirts Look for it! Some of our members who do not wish to March will be staking out a place on the Capitol Lawn. We will TRY to balance sun, shade, closeness to speakers and ability to hang banner.

Do we have to stay together or are we free to go and do what we want?

You are free to wander as much as you like. We will have a reserved spot at the Capitol lawn for the rally with as much room as we can get. We will meet one hour after the rally is over for the bus ride home.

Will we be able to leave stuff on the bus the day of the rally?
